“Mr. President, please resign for the good of the country!”

This appeal comes from the Christian Democratic Party (CDP) in reaction to the news that Pres. Jacob Zuma has fathered a 20th child, after the existence of yet another child born outside of wedlock became known.

“Our country needs a leader acting as a moral compass, not a president imitating Tiger Woods, Bill Clinton and King Henry VIII all in one, and all for the wrong reasons.” So says Rev. Theunis Botha, leader of the CDP and acting chair of the Christian Democratic Alliance (CDA).
