Foul play, says CDP on EEB

“The EEB (Employment Equity Bill) and BEE (Black Economic empowerment) are both racially based policies devised by the ANC to pull the wool over black voters eyes, and to keep them thinking of themselves as the ‘previously disadvantaged’, who are now being advantaged by the ANC” says Rev Theunis Botha, Leader of the Christian Democratic Party (CDP).

“That of course is absolute nonsense, as the ANC’s record for the past 17 years speaks for itself. Whatsoever they have put their corrupt hands to, has brought the country closer and closer to becoming like the rest of Africa, where a rich elite rules over the poverty stricken without conscience or consideration. To accuse Solidarity of playing ‘a dangerous political game’ and say that it ‘is reckless to play racial politics, and spread falsehoods and distortions’ is a laugh, considering the fact, that it is exactly the type of politics the ANC appears to thrive on.”

“True to form, they have devised a Bill that if not vehemently opposed will be used as yet another law to tighten its strangle hold on minorities in South Africa. Although Motshega claims to have liberated and empowered Coloureds and Indians, in reality the opposite is true as many within these minority groups are actually being marginalized and enslaved to poverty and deprived of equal opportunities.”
