CDP reageer op Terre'Blanche se moord

Die leier van die Christen-Demokratiese Party (CDP), ds. Theunis Botha, het met skok op die nuus van nog 'n plaasmoord, dié keer op die AWB-leier, mnr. Eugene Terre'Blanche geregeer. CDP on Terre'Blanche's murder

The Leader of the Christian Democratic Party CDP reacted with shock at the news of yet another murder of a farmer, this time Eugene Terre'Blanche leader of the AWB. Rev Botha, who is also the acting chairman of the Christian Democratic Alliance CDA said, that the viciousness of the attack on Mr Terre'Blanche, who was mutilated with a pipe and panga, underlines what happens when a so called leader stirs up hatred and revenge by defying a court interdict and continuing to encourage his gullible followers to 'kill the boer'.

"The fact that it was reported that those who were arrested are two of Mr Terre'Blanche's farm workers who had not been paid, rings hollow when one considers how many of these brutal farm murders have taken place in just the first three months of this year. "

"This insanity must stop and if it doesn't the ANC government must bear the blame and the red stain of blood will be on their hands."
