CDP reacts to farm family murder

“Easter, for Christians, is the celebration of the highest expression of love imaginable, Christ the Lord dying on the cross for our sins, and being resurrected. Unfortunately, many South Africans will remember this Easter as a time when yet another farmer and his family were murdered, although the facts are as yet in a haze, and Julius Malema said that he is being persecuted as Jesus was.” So says Christian Democratic Party (CDP) leader, Rev. Theunis Botha, reacting to reports that a farmer, his wife and 14 year old daughter had been murdered at Griqua Town, and that Malema had articulated yet another off-tune chant.

“Surely, this is no way to celebrate Easter. We demand that the ANC now focus more on what is in the interest of the country, rather than on internal squabbles arising from the end of the year leadership challenge.

“We trust that the police will soon apprehend all farm murderers who are still on the loose.”
