CDP oor Zuma se volgende huwelik

“Pres. Jacob se komende huwelik en uitbreidende veelwywery raak nou so algemeen soos sy vreemde godsdiensuitsprake, en bizarre uitsprake oor die grondwet en die regsspraak. Dit dra egter ook by tot die toenemende verleentheid vir die land in die wêreldgemeenskap,” sê ds. Theunis Botha, leier van die Christen-Demokratiese Party (CDP).

“Soos daar geen self te smeer is aan Zuma se verbintenis tot veelwywery nie, so is verantwoordelike presidentskap skynbaar bloot buite sy begripsvermoë. Pas het een van sy ministers, dr. Blade Nzimande, die grondwetlike demokrasie na die maan gestuur deur te verklaar dat die meerderheid sal regeer en dat die grondwet nie sal verhinder dat die meerderheidswil sal seëvier nie.

“Dr. Nzimande, as minister, het trou aan die grondwet beloof en behoort summier afgedank te word. Dieselfde geld vir Zuma wat ook die onderhandelde skikking as opofferbaar vir die rewolusie beskou. “Zuma en ‘n groot deel van sy kabinet is niks anders as verleenthede vir die land nie, en is nie gesik om die land te lei nie.”

CDP reacts to Zuma’s next wedding

“Pres. Jacob Zuma’s upcoming wedding and the extension to his polygamy is now as common as his bizarre religious utterances and his remarks on constitutionality and the judiciary. It, however, adds to the increasing embarrassment of the country in the eyes of the international community,” says Rev. Theunis Botha, leader of the Christian Democratic Party (CDP).

“As there is no stopping Zuma’s commitment to polygamy so there appears to be no stopping his noncommitment to responsible presidency. Recently one of his Ministers, Dr. Blade Nzimande, attacked constitutional democracy declaring that the constitution will not stand in the way of majority rule.

“Dr. Nzimande, as minister, however swore allegiance to the constitution, and should be summarily fired. The same applies to Zuma who regards the negotiated settlement as something that must be sacrificed for the ongoing revolution.

“Zuma and many of his cabinet are an embarrassment to the country and not fit to rule.”
