**AG report on municipalities: Abandon cadre deployment says CDP**

“The pathetic state of municipal audits in South Africa totally overshadows the marginal improvement pointed out in certain categories,” says Christian Democratic Party (CDP) leader, Theunis Botha. He reacted to the latest AG report, which amongst others, pointed out that only seven municipalities, including one metro, received unqualified reports.

“The set ideal of a 100% clean audit by 2014, seems to be pie in the sky despite continued assurances of government that the target will be met.”

“We call on government to abandon its policy of cadre deployment, and that the best people for the jobs are appointed. Cadre deployment, in any case, is not tolerable in a democracy where there should be a clear distinction between government and ruling party.”

“Ons doen ‘n beroep op die regering om sy beleid van kader-ontplooiing te laat vaar, en die beste mense vir die werk aan te stel. Kader-ontplooiing is in elk geval strydig met die demokratiese begrip van skeiding tussen regering en regerende politieke party.”
