**Ban on advertising of alcohol - Not the ultimate cure but ultimate control**

"True to its socialist obsession and objectives the ANC is becoming more and more intrusive in the lives of South Africans" says Rev Theunis Botha, leader of the Christian Democratic Party (CDP).

"The last thing a Christian Democratic Party would be expected to oppose is legislation to stop the advertising of Alcoholic beverages, and the last thing we would have done is oppose it had we been convinced that it would actually curb alcoholism.

"The fact is that many jobs could be lost and sports sponsorships be adversely affected. The government's banning of the advertising of alcohol will not solve the problem of alcoholism. Just as their continual speaking against corruption has not curbed corruption. What is needed is for the nation to be inspired by a government of integrity, to repair its moral compass.

"The statement by Aaron Motsoaledi, the minister of health, that the government is obliged to make decisions on behalf of citizens, which implies that they are incapable of making decisions for themselves, is symptomatic of a government that is determined to progressively take more power into its hands and that is ready to force it's will, on the people.

"The CDP has consistently warned South Africans to guard against a government that promises to do too much for them, as they will ask too much of them."
