More shocking hikes for Pretoria?

“A rumour is doing the rounds that the Tshwane Metro is considering calling a special Council meeting to announce and approve an even further 4% increase in the electricity tariff,” says Rev Theunis Botha Leader of the Christian Democratic Party (CDP).

“All the latest tariff increases came into effect on the 1st of July only after public/participation meetings were held. Although the majority of those present at these meetings felt that the increases were excessive and would put further pressure on the tax/payers who are already reeling under these never ending increases, which are due to the ANC’s failures and uncontrollable greed, they were implemented.”

“ With no public participation called for and the haste with which this latest increase is being pushed through, one can only surmise that it has come about as a result of the unacceptable and unjustifiable annual salary of R 2.7 M that the ANC council has approved for the new city manager.”

“The Christian Democratic Party is appalled that from national through to provincial and local levels self/indulgent opportunists are legalizing the pillaging of the country’s treasury, by paying themselves salaries far beyond their capabilities. Stop this insane and deliberate destruction of our economy and stop it now.”
