Questionable dealings in Tshwane Metro - CDP

“It was strongly suggested by some that the Mayor of Tshwane Metro, Kgositso Ramokgopa, an outspoken supporter of Kgalema Motlanthe, in the race for president of the ANC, was on his way out after Zuma ‘s ‘landslide’ victory in Manuag”, says Rev Theunis Botha Leader of the Christian Democratic Party (CDP).
