**Sack Nyanda now - CDP**

The Christian Democratic Party repeated its call for Pres. Jacob Zuma, to relieve the minister of Communications, Gen. Siphwe Nyanda of his position.

“Previously Pres. Zuma indicated that there was no proof to implicate Nyanda. Now the Public Protector has found that Nyanda is at least morally accountable as beneficiary of tenders by Transnet, even if there was no proof that he wrongfully influenced the process. If Zuma still does not act, the country will know what has been suspected for a long time – and that is that hard words on corruption, is merely lip service.”
