Behoorlike bestuur, skoon administrasie, en toewyding is die grondslae vir sukses. ‘n Regering wat nie deur voorbeeld lei nie, gaan groot moeite hê om die land volgens sy potensiaal te laat presteer.”

“Stirring comments on nationalisation is not dampened, but efforts are made to smother the country’s right to freedom of opinion and press freedom. Whilst many government employees, many of them teachers, are on strike, Newsweek publishes data where South Africa scores the 82nd place as successful country out of 100 countries, and 97th as far as education goes,” says Christian Democratic Party (CDP) leader, Rev. Theunis Botha.

“We are grateful for the many dedicated teachers, but this clearly indicates that money alone can not fix all problems. Proper management, clean administration and dedication are essential. ‘n Government not leading by example will find it impossible to reap achievement according to potential.”
