Malema-hearing now full fledged power struggle

“Some interesting dynamics are developing ahead of the ANC’s disciplinary hearing of Youth League leader, Julius Malema, with the more radical elements in the ANC apparently going full out to embarrass Pres. Jacob Zuma,” says Christian Democratic Party (CDP) leader, Rev. Theunis Botha.

“With the overt support for Malema from both Min. Lindiwe Sisulu and Winnie Madikazela-Mandela, one must consider the possibility of a Xhosa bid for power, along with getting the radical agenda back on track, says Botha.

“This is clearly no longer a disciplinary hearing, but a power struggle show down. One can only trust that the criminal investigations against those incriminated will take its full course, irrespective of the outcome. The Public Protector’s abandoning of the Malema-investigation because of a lack of funds is a major set back for getting the country back on track, and to ensure that responsibility is restored.”

Die Openbare Beskermer se ondersoek na Malema weens ‘n geldtekort is ‘n ernstige terugslag om die land weer terug op die spoor te kry, en verantwoordelikheid die botoon te laat voer.”
