CDP responds to 9/11 commemoration

“Our hearts and thoughts are with the American people as they commemorate the 9/11 attacks which killed almost 3 000 people,” says Rev. Theunis Botha, leader of the Christian Democratic Party (CDP).

“The aftermath is not only one of sorrow, but also of heroism, care and pride.

“We are however concerned that Pres. Barack Obama has not taken a wise course in his response to Syria. We agree that Assad needs to be punished in terms of international law if he was indeed guilty of the poison gas attack on civilians, but we believe there are better ways of solving a very complicated situation.

“The mere fact that the US government warned that there may be reprisal attacks should, in the wake of the 9/11 commemoration, be sufficient to seek wisdom and not blood.”
