**SA moet beter vriende kies**

Die Christen-Demokratiese Party (CDP) het sy teleurstelling uitgespreek dat Suid-Afrika in die VN- Veiligheidsraad buite stemming gebly het in 'n mosie wat die skending van menseregte en die staking van geweld in Sirië vra.

Theunis Botha, leier van die CDP.

**SA must choose friends better**

“The Christian Democratic Party (CDP) expressed its disappointment with South Africa abstaining in the United Nations Security Council from voting in a motion calling for an end to the human rights violations and violence in Syria.

“The apparent enthusiasm with which they support human rights violations in countries such as Mianmar, Zimbabwe, Venezuela, Ghaddafi’s Libya, Cuba and China casts a dark shadow over the ANC’s commitment to human rights – especially when it comes to the constant criticism of the status of the constitution and stipulations in the Bill of Human Rights, such as the right to own property,” says Rev. Theunis Botha, leader of the CDP.

“To add insult to injury, the latest bungling comes against the back drop of the disastrous way in which the Dalai Lama’s visa application was handled.

“If South Africa insists on expressing loyalty to friends in international politics, we urge that they choose better friends.”
