ANC racist

"It should now be abundantly clear to those who still believe that the ANC embraces a policy of non-racialism, that such a policy, if it ever existed within the ANC, has been scrapped. By siding with Julius Malema it is now obvious that the ANC has taken a firm stance when it comes to other population groups being insulted and discriminated against."

So says Christian Democratic Party (CDP) leader, Rev. Theunis Botha, reacting to the news that Julius Malema now allegedly referred to Indians as co*ies.

"This latest incident comes against the back drop of the ANC's appeal in the Malema hate speech ruling, for singing a song in which it is said that white people must be shot.

"Despite claiming that the promised racial quotas at provincial level, which would disadvantage coloured in the Western Cape and Indians in KZN, was a misunderstanding and would be scrapped, it has now come to light that Correctional Services in the Western Cape were strictly adhering to national quotas, to the disadvantage of coloureds.

"The previous government, often labelled the apartheid regime, twenty years ago scrapped the last racial legislation. The ANC has over the past 17 years re-introduced numerous racial laws. Surely, it cannot claim to be non-racial."

ANC rassisties

"Dit is nou klokhelder dat hulle wat glo die ANC omarm 'n beleid van nie-rassigheid, dat die ANC dit nou laat vaar het indien dit ooit hoegenaamd die party se beleid was. So sê die leier van die Christen-Demokratiese Party in reaksie op die nuus dat Malema na Indiërs as ko*ies verwys het.

"Dit geskied teen die agtergrond dat die ANC appèl aanteken teen die haatspraakverhoor teen Malema waarin die skiet van blankes aangehits word.

"Ten spyte van ondernemings dat die skrap van provinsiale rassekwotas nie die bruin mense in die Wes-Kaap en Indiërs in KwaZulu-Natal; sou benadeel nie, is dit nou onthul dat Korrektiewe Dienste in die Wes-Kaap presies dit doen deur nasionale rassekwotas in daardie provinsie in te stel.

"Twintig jaar gelede het die vorige regering, dikwels as die apartheidsregime uitgeskel, die laaste rassewetgewing uit die wetboek verwyder. Die afgelope 17 jaar het die ANC 'n magdom rassewetgewing op die wetboek geplaas. So 'n party kan hom MOS nie op nie-rassigheid beroep nie."
