## **Government warns of fifth Covid wave**

Government, putting on the cloak of the prophet, in a statement made on Friday 25 March warned South Africans of a fifth wave of Covid infection that could attack the country. One wonders what “scientific” evidence they have received from China and the WHO to justify such a warning. They say that South Africans needed to remain vigilant, as Covid has not been defeated. This was also the reason, according to them, that the National State of Disaster was once again going to be extended. This time to 15 April 2022.

Blaming this possible surge on the fact that many people have not been vaccinated the government urged all people older than twelve to do so. ## **Regering waarsku oor die 5de Covid golf**
