Theunis Botha, leier van die CDP. “Ons spreek ons innige meegevoel uit met die naasbestaendes van die 51-jarige Radesh Anadlal en die 78-jarige Jacobus Wartington, veral met mev. Anna Wartington wat in die aanval op haar man self wreed aangerand is.”

“Ons doen ook 'n beroep op die regering om vir 'n slag behoorlik bestek op te neem oor die situasie en die aanvalle nie net ten sterkste te veroordeel nie, maar ook iets daaraan doen.”

CDP reacts to farm murders

The Christian Democratic Party (CDP) reacted with dismay at the news that two more farmers have been murdered within the space of only a few days, while an elderly lady was viciously assaulted.

“The latest farm attacks – one in KZN and one in the Northern Cape - once again emphasises the fact that nobody living on a farm these days is safe from attack by these callous murderers.” says Rev. Theunis Botha, leader of the CDP. “We express our sincerest condolences with the next of kin of the 51 year old Radesh Anandal and the 78 year old Jacobus Wartington, and also especially with Mrs. Anna Wartington who was savagely assaulted during the killing of her husband.”

“We again insist that government takes a serious view of incidents such as these and that they not only condemn it in the strongest terms but acutally begin to do something about the situation.”
