Malema herinner al meer aan Idi Amin - CDA

“Hoe meer ‘n mens van Julius Malema sien en hoor, hoe meer laat dit ‘n mens aan Idi Amin dink,” aldus die CDA se sportwoordvoerder, Richard Botha.

“Sy onverantwoordelike optredes en veral sy rassistiese uitlatings skep die indruk dat sy mond nie altyd met sy brein verbind is nie. Sy onvoorwaardelike en bykans fanatiese steun aan die korruptes en onbekwames is onvanpas. Dié keer het hy sy aansienlike gewig agter die selferkende leuenaar, Leonard Chuene ingewerp en verklaar dat ‘hy een van ons eie’ is en dat die waarheid ‘immaterieel’ is.

“Na sy suksesvolle intimidasie van Nando’s durf hy nou Nedbank met groot bravade aan om die gevolge te dra sou die bank sy steun aan ASA onttrek. Net soos die vraag onlangs gevra is waar Malema die geld vandaan kry om so ‘n uitspattige lewenstyl vol te hou, kan die vraag nou ook gevra word wie hom rugsteun dat hy so vrypostig kan aangaan en daarmee wegkom?”

“Malema baai in publisiteit en sal enigiets aanvang en kwytraak om in die kollig te bly.

“Die CDA aanvaar Nedbank se verduidelikings oor waarom hy sy steun aan ASA onttrek, en nou is ook die tyd om beide Malema en Chuene die trekpas te gee weens die verleentheid wat hulle vir die land skep.”

Who is running the Country?

Richard Botha, CDA spokesman on sport said that:

“The more one hears and sees of Julius Malema the more one is reminded of IDI AMIN. His irresponsible actions and especially racist utterances give the impression that his mouth is not always connected to his brain. His unconditional and almost fanatical support for the corrupt and inept is uncanny. This time he has thrown his considerable weight behind the self confessed liar Chuene stating that ‘He is one of our own’, and ‘The truth is immaterial’,

After his successful intimidation of Nandos, he now, with great bravado, threatens and ‘dares’ Nedbank to withdraw its support for ASA and face the consequences.

It was asked recently where Malema gets the money from, that allows him his lavish lifestyle, equally, it should be asked, who is behind him that gives him the cheek to carry on the way he does, and to get away with it.”

Botha said that Malema is a publicity-seeker who will use all means available to draw attention to himself.
